Why was this fund created?

The Community Prosperity Fund (CPF) was created in partnership with the Government of BC, Community Foundations of Canada and over 50 local community foundations to invest \$25 million into BC's non-profit sector — empowering community foundations to support their local charities and non-profits that are reducing poverty and promoting social inclusion.

Vancouver Foundation distributed \$3.7 million to community service organizations in Vancouver, New Westminister and Burnaby.



CPF is part of the Government of BC's ongoing commitment to supporting the non-profit sector's overall recovery, adaptability, and resiliency to ensure stronger communities across the province.
