(300-word limit)	 ✓ Identify which system(s) your organization is influencing. ✓ Briefly describe how your organization is working to influence the system(s) identified. ✓ Explain the main issues within these systems that your organization addresses. ✓ Provide concrete examples and details of your work in these areas.
 2. How will this funding request support one or more of the above designated use of funds? (300-word limit) Transforming Systems Grants are intended to support existing work by funding one or more of the following: Sustaining, deepening and/or expanding current operations and initiatives, Building networks and forming strategic partnerships, and/or Amplifying reach and effectiveness 	 ✓ Clearly state how the funding will be used in your ongoing work to address the issues you have identified. ✓ Provide specific examples and explain how the funding is aligned to one or more of the designated use of funds.
3. What communities does your organization serve? How do you ensure that those most affected are represented, included, and exercising self-determination in the work? (300-word limit)	 ✓ Identify the communities your organization serves, including demographic groups, populations, regions, and relevant intersectional categories. ✓ Explain your strategies and practices for ensuring representation and inclusion of those most affected. ✓ Describe how you support those most affected to influence decisions and shape their future. ✓ Describe how the issues you are addressing have been identified as priorities by the community.

Some examples may include, but are not limited to activist groups, grassroots groups, non-profit organizations, government agencies and policymakers, educational and research institutions, legal advocates, allied organizations in related sectors.

(400-word limit or 5 minutes speaking time)	 ✓ Describe the overall organizational or governance structure (e.g., hierarchical, flat, and/or other non-traditional structures). ✓ Describe how the structure and leadership roles (e.g., board of directors, senior leadership, advisory committees, elders) prioritize and embody practices of intersectionality, allyship, and mutual liberation. ✓ Explain key decision-making processes and identify the individuals or groups whose input is considered. Specify who provides recommendations or feedback and who has the authority to make the final decisions.

Transforming Systems Grants are intended to support existing work by funding <u>one or more</u> of the following:

- Sustaining, deepening, and/or expanding current operations and initiatives
- Building networks and/or forming strategic partnerships
- Amplifying your organization's reach and effectiveness

- ✓ A formal budget is not required.
- ✓ Provide a high-level breakdown of how funds will be allocated and how these expenditures contribute to your organization's work.
- ✓ Describe how funding aligns to <u>one or</u> <u>more</u> of the designated use of funds:
 - Sustaining, deepening, and/or expanding current operations and initiatives,
 - Building networks, forming strategic partnerships,
 - Amplifying your organization's reach and effectiveness.
- ✓ Provide specific examples or strategies for each priority, if applicable.
