Why was this fund created?

The Lighthouse Organizations Fund (LOF) was made possible through a \$22.9 million dollar investment by the Government of BC. LOF distributed multi-year operational grants of \$993,000 to charities in BC that are addressing poverty reduction and social inclusion across the province.

The recipients of LOF are large, multi-service organizations with a provincial or regional footprint. This funding will support their important work to reduce poverty and help alleviate the growing demand on their services.
